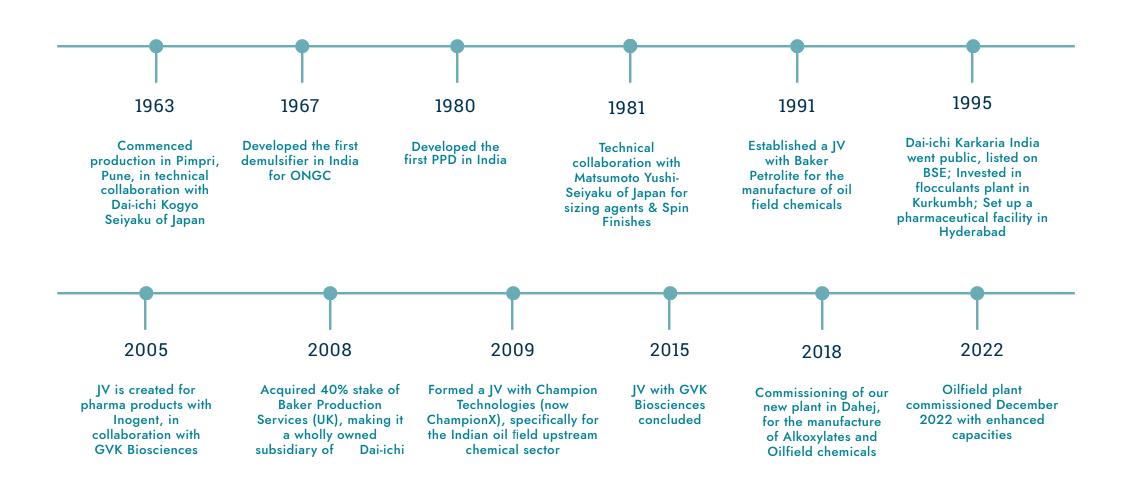

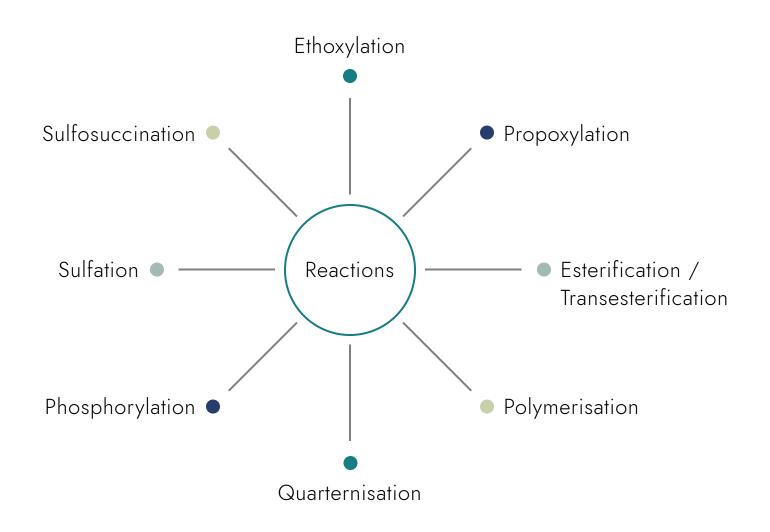

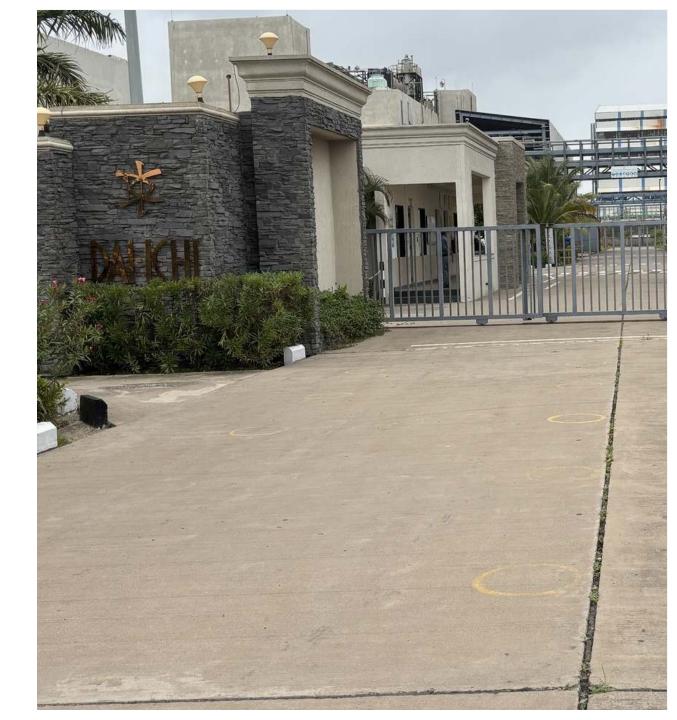

Q2 FY25-26 RESULTS



MANAGEMENT NOTE

During the second quarter of FY 2025-26, the Company recorded sales of ₹42.7 crore, representing a growth of 7% in volume and 17% in value compared to the same period of the previous year. While overall industry sentiment remained subdued due to global trade uncertainties and selective demand slowdown in export linked sectors, performance remained steady, supported by a diversified portfolio and stable operations. Performance was led by the oilfield segment, which recorded growth on account of higher overseas demand and sustained volumes from key accounts. Other segments remained steady, with moderate movement in domestic markets and a slight softening in export demand.

Despite near term challenges in certain end use industries, we continued to strengthen our product mix and focused on value added opportunities through ongoing development work in priority segments. Operationally, the Dahej site maintained stable performance, supported by improvements in batch cycle times, optimisation of production planning, and increased equipment reliability. The quarter saw the successful commissioning of additional reactor capacity for resin based products, scale up of key batch processes, and completion of several new product trials as part of ongoing capability enhancement. The ethoxylation unit continued to operate at optimal efficiency, contributing significantly to overall throughput. With the existing ethoxylation reactor operating at full capacity, the installation of the new ethoxylation reactor is progressing as planned and is expected to be commissioned in the next financial year. This expansion will enhance production capability and support our growth in high demand segments. Energy, water, and fuel consumption levels remained within control, with continued focus on resource efficiency and process optimisation. We maintain our commitment to safe and compliant operations, strengthening internal safety procedures and operational discipline in line with established standards.

In summary, Q2 reflected steady progress in a moderately challenging business environment. Focused execution, cost management, and stronger contribution from the oilfield business supported performance during the quarter. With stable operations, high utilisation in key manufacturing units, and encouraging traction in strategic product areas, we remain well placed to deliver sustainable growth in the second half of the financial year.
